We provide counselling, support services, advocacy, education, and prevention. The Kamloops Sexual Assault Counselling Centre's purpose is to provide client centered support services to all individuals regardless of race, culture, religious beliefs, gender, sexual orientation, ability, socio-economic status, and age.

General Description

KSACC is hiring for a Part-Time Temporary Contract position. This one year, 20 hour/week contract is a partnership between the Kamloops Sexual Assault Counselling Centre and the Kamloops Immigrant Services. This position is an exciting opportunity for someone who is interested in providing prevention, advocacy, and counselling services to individuals who may have multiple barriers to accessing services. This person will work to support new immigrants, refugees, permanent residents, naturalized Canadian Citizens, temporary residents living in Kamloops such as foreign workers, post-secondary foreign students and refugee claimants that have experienced violence or at risk of experiencing violence. Building trust, creating safety, and building a foundational relationship is the focus of the work in this position

Position Requirements

- A minimum of a BSW or equivalent is required, however, a Master's degree in human services is preferred.
- Access to a vehicle with appropriate insurance
- Knowledge and experience supporting clients affected by relationship violence
- Knowledge and experience supporting culturally diverse individuals

Specific Expectations

1. Assesses the safety of the clients and their children. Supports clients to develop a safety plan.
2. Interviews clients, prepares case histories, assesses problems and outlines services provided by the organization.

3. Provides individual and group counselling to clients from a feminist and trauma-informed perspective
 4. Provides information and referrals to relevant community service providers, resources and professionals as required.
 5. Participates in collaborative case conferences as required.
 6. Maintains related records and statistics and produces reports as required.
 7. Maintains current knowledge of issues and resources related to abuse and violence. Conducts presentations and public awareness activities about services and issues.
 8. Work in collaboration with both KSACC and KIS staff.
 9. Performs other related duties as assigned by Agency Coordinator.
