Permanent – Part-time (21 hours/week)

POSTION SUMMARY

The Kamloops Sexual Assault Counselling Centre (KSACC) is looking to hire a SAIP Counsellor. The SAIP Counsellor provides assessment, treatment and support services to children and youth age 3 to 18 years who have been sexually abused and/or sexually exploited. The Counsellor will also be responsible for providing support services to non-offending family members or caregivers as required. Resources permitting, the SAIP Counsellor may also provide community education and awareness on the issues of child sexual abuse and sexual exploitation. The position is considered a permanent, part-time position.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct client intake and assessments and determine program suitability. Refer clients to appropriate external programs as required
- Develop and implement support plans and goals necessary to meet client needs
- Participate in case management with KSACC's Clinical Supervisor/Case Manager to ensure excellence in practice.
- Conduct consistent file management including the maintenance of client information, forms related to privacy and confidentiality, client notes and other items related to file management
- Maintain statistics that adhere to funder and agency requirements
- Conduct referrals, case management and/or advocacy with other community service providers as necessary
- Provide information, education and support to non-offending caregivers of the victim
- Provide outreach services and crisis intervention as required
- Actively promote the program to other service providers and the community at large

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

- Master's degree related to counselling and/or equivalent
- Minimum 2 years' experience with children and families
- Clean criminal record check
- Valid BC driver's license
- Access to a vehicle with appropriate business insurance
